Easy Options for Bequest Giving

Through a bequest, you can demonstrate an enduring commitment to and continue the pattern of philanthropy established during your lifetime. Those who notify The Alaska Community Foundation of bequests are invited to join the Legacy Society and will receive recognition, now and in the future. Participating in the Legacy Society will also encourage others to consider bequests as both a planned giving option and a way of giving back to their communities.

A bequest can easily be made by naming the Anchorage Post, Society of American Military Engineer, Benjamin B. Talley Scholarship Endowment Fund, at The Alaska Community Foundation, as beneficiary. If you already have a will in place, a simple codicil can be written.

The following is sample language only. We encourage you to contact program staff at the Alaska Community Foundation and an estate planning attorney to determine exactly which language is most appropriate to fulfill your goals for your charitable legacy.
