

Sample Bequest Language

Through a bequest, you can demonstrate an enduring commitment to Alaska and continue the pattern of philanthropy established during your lifetime. Those who notify us of bequests are invited to join our Legacy Society and will receive recognition, now and in the future, that will in turn encourage others to consider bequests as both a planned giving option and a way of giving back to their communities.

A bequest can easily be made by naming The Alaska Community Foundation as beneficiary. An outright bequest may be unrestricted, may add to an existing fund of the Foundation or may establish a new fund. If a donor already has a will in place, a simple codicil can be written.

The following is sample language only. We encourage you to contact program staff at the Alaska Community Foundation and an estate planning attorney to determine exactly which language is most appropriate to fulfill your goals for your charitable legacy.
